Gallery Row Walks This Way

The Gallery Row group kicks off the first in a series of events this week with its Downtown Art Walk. On Sept. 9, the group will host a self-guided walking tour of the galleries, cultural institutions and museums that pepper Downtown. It will be repeated the second Tuesday of every month. The September tour, which starts at noon, has eight participants: The Museum of Contemporary Art, Geffen Contemporary (152 N. Central Ave.); The Space (125 W. Fourth St.); Bank (400 S. Main St.); Gallery 727 (727 S. Spring St.); Milla Angelina Gallery (729 S. Spring St.); the Museum of Neon Art (501 W. Olympic Blvd.); sixspace (549 W. 23rd St.); and Art Share (801 E. Fourth Pl.). Bert Green, a tour organizer and a member of the non-profit Gallery Row organization, said he expects five more galleries to sign on for
